Water Valve Exercising Program

June-November 2018

Starting in June and running through November, Monday to Friday, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Trenton Water Works will perform preventive maintenance of its water-system infrastructure using a contract vendor, Wachs Water. Wachs Water will be executing TWW's **Water Valve Exercising Program** to ensure reliability and performance of valve equipment and water quality. Wachs's technicians will locate and test the operation of the valves in TWW's service area, opening and closing each valve, operating the valve through two full cycles, and returning the valve to the open position.

During the **Water Valve Exercising Program**, customers may experience some discolored water and/or lower-than-normal water pressures. If customers notice cloudy or discolored water, they should run several cold water taps at full force for a period of one to two minutes until the cloudy or discolored water clears. In some cases, it may be necessary to repeat this process after 30 minutes.
