Trenton Ethics Board Seeks Two Additional Members

TRENTON, NJ – The Trenton Ethics Board announced today that the deadline for Trenton residents to submit a letter of interest and resume to be considered for appointment to the Trenton Ethics Board is Wednesday, October 28, 2015.

There are two vacancies to be filled on the Trenton Ethics Board. The City Council adopted a resolution directing that the Trenton Ethics Board make recommendations to fill vacancies. The appointments will be made by City Council.

Under state law and municipal ordinance, no more than three of the six Trenton Ethics Board members may be of the same political party. There are currently two members who are registered as Democrats. No more than one additional registered Democrat may be appointed to the Trenton Ethics Board, but both new appointees may be either registered Republicans or Independents.

Persons interested in being considered for appointment should send a letter of interest and resume to the Trenton Ethics Board by email to TrentonEthicsBoard@trentonnj.org or by regular mail or hand delivery to the Trenton Ethics Board, % Office of the City Clerk, 319 East State Street, Trenton, NJ 08608. The letter and resume must be received by October 28, 2015. Applicants should specify whether they are a member of a political party, and if so, which party.

At its meeting on November 4, 2015, which will be held at City Hall and starts at 7:00 pm, the Trenton Ethics Board will interview applicants for appointment to the Trenton Ethics Board. Prior to the meeting applicants will be notified of the approximate time of their interview.

The Trenton Ethics Board will recommend two people for appointment. City Council makes the final decision on appointment of members of the Trenton Ethics Board.

The Trenton Ethics Board investigates and rules on allegations of violations of the Trenton Code of Ethics by officers and employees serving the City of Trenton. The Board also provides training and advisory opinions on ethical conduct to officers and employees of the City. For more information on the Trenton Ethics Board, visit www.trentonethicsboard.org.
