Contractors must possess a valid Home Improvement Contractor's License, and an EPA Lead Safe Certification*. General Accident and Liability insurance as well as Workman's Compensation insurance are required. **Minority and women-owner contractors are encouraged to participate.**

***EPA Lead Safe Certification and Lead Abatement Certification Courses will be offered free of charge later this year.**
