### **Impending Hazardous Weather**

TRENTON: The National Weather Service is predicting a major snowstorm affecting our area from Friday night into Sunday. This storm may produce snow accumulations in excess of 8 inches.

During previous snowstorms experienced in the City of Trenton, a number of vehicles have had to be towed off the roadways in order to make way for the snowplows to plow the streets. The Trenton Police Department would like to remind citizens that emergency snow removal is covered by City of Trenton Code 14-2.10. This Code can be found in its entirety on the City of Trenton website under the "City Clerk" tab.

According to the code, emergency snow removal can take effect whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the street and highway. No vehicle shall be parked on the major roadways referred to in the code or any other roadways that are posted. Vehicles found on the roadways during these times will be towed at the owner's expense and a summons may be issued for a violation of city code. A list of the major roadways is attached.

Residents who routinely park on the major roadways referred to in the city code are asked to be cognizant of potential weather conditions and to seek alternative parking solutions whenever the possibility of emergency snow removal becomes necessary. Residents may park in the listed school parking lots for the duration of the storm. When parking in the school lots, residents should park in a marked parking space, otherwise the plows will not be able to plow the parking lots and their vehicle may be towed, resulting in tow and storage fees. Residents shall then be notified by way of the City of Trenton's website and automated telephone messaging system when vehicles should be moved from the school lots. Owners of vehicles left in the designated school lots at least two hours after the notifications regarding the removal of the vehicles from the lots have been made, may also be responsible for towing and storage fees.

**The Trenton Police Department recommends that city residents register their email address and phone numbers on the City of Trenton's website in order to receive emergency notices.**
