Latino Advisory Council to Meet on Monday, February 29

Trenton, N.J. — Building on the interest garnered at their January 2016 meeting, the Latino Advisory Council will convene a second session that will focus on civic engagement and education for community leaders, stakeholders and residents on Monday, February 29 between 6:30–8 p.m. at City Hall. This session will seek to engage the Latino community in Trenton to safeguard and make certain they are fairly represented through service on various local boards, appointments, commissions, and other decision making bodies. Recognition of the strengths and contributions of Trenton's Latino community, which represents nearly 34 percent of the city's population, will be a key topic of discussion.

The Latino Advisory Council advises Mayor Eric Jackson and his administration on myriad issues that impact Trenton's broader Latino community, including public safety; immigration; social and human services; business and economic development; entrepreneurship; education; and government representation and access to municipal government services.
