Volunteers with the Red Cross, Bellevue Area Civic Association, Shiloh Baptist Church, and Trenton Fire and Emergency Services will be going door-to-door in select neighborhoods offering free smoke alarm installations in homes that need them. Volunteers will also be distributing fire safety information and talking to families about what they can do now to be prepared should a fire break out in their home. All Red Cross volunteers will be wearing a Red Cross identification tag while canvassing. Please feel free to request to see ID.
