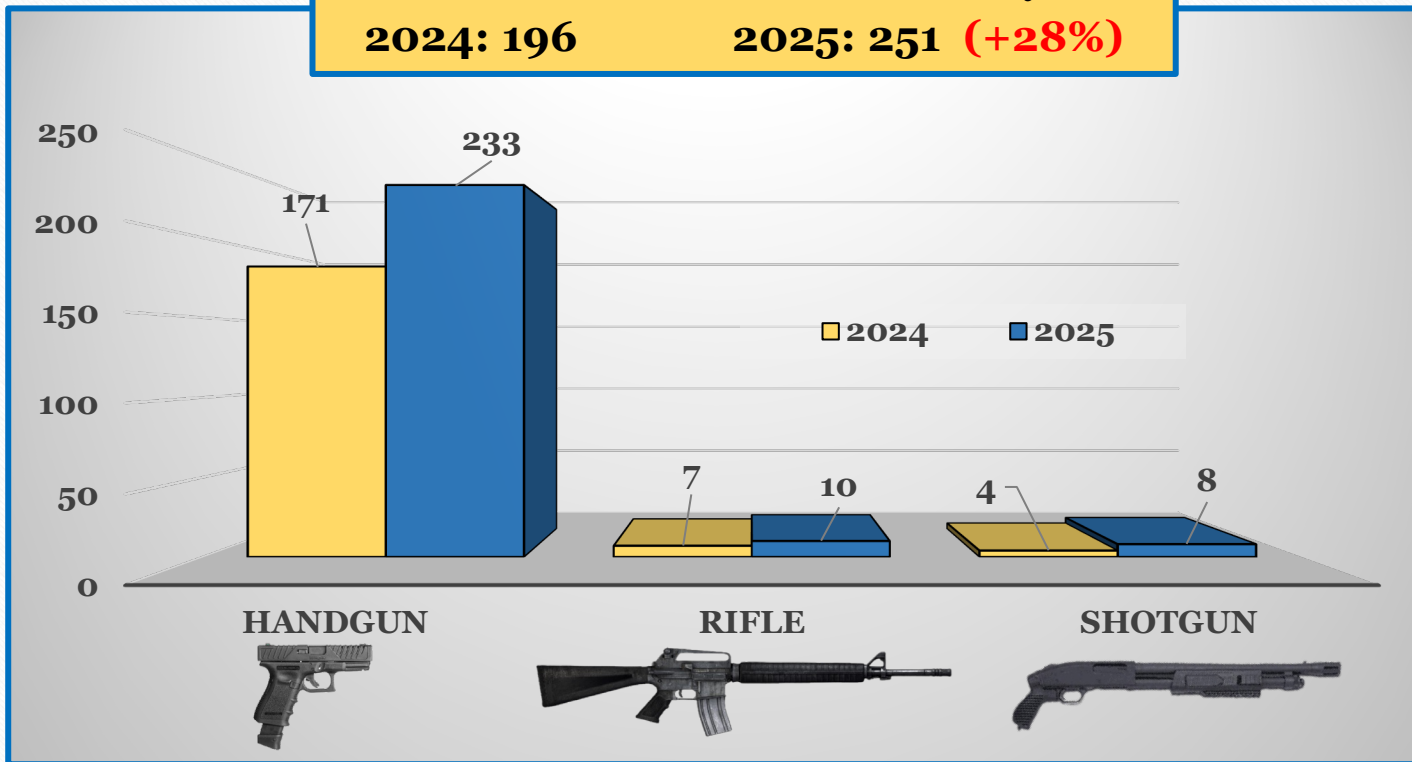

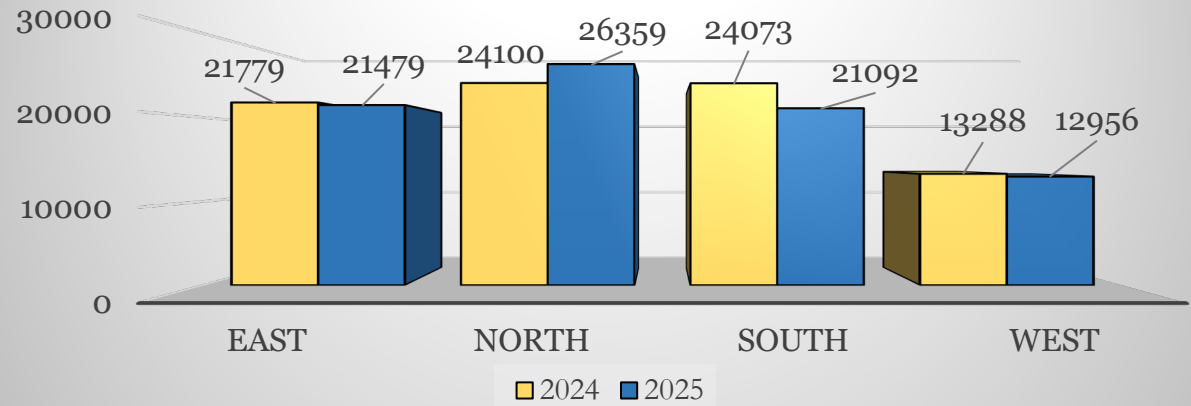

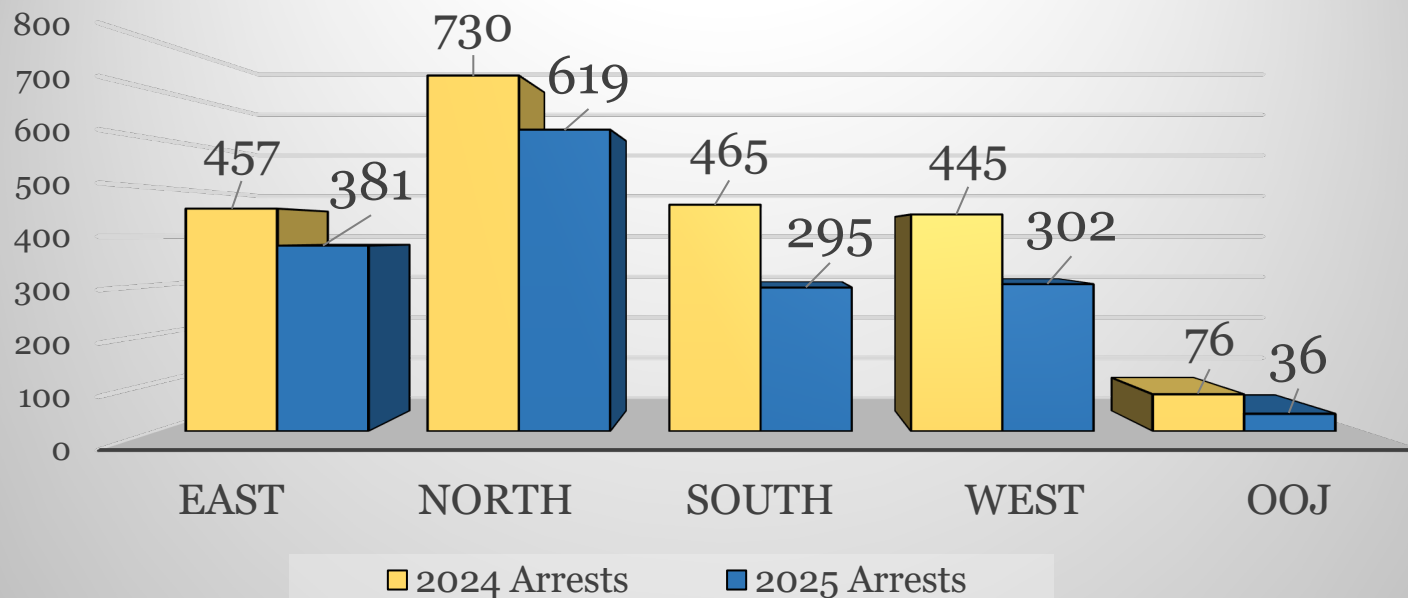

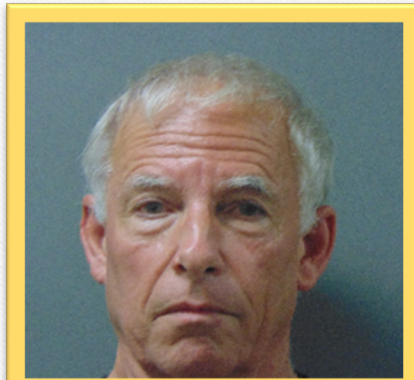
Criminal Investigation Bureau – Undercover operation # 3

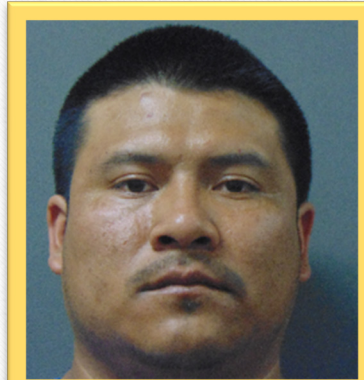

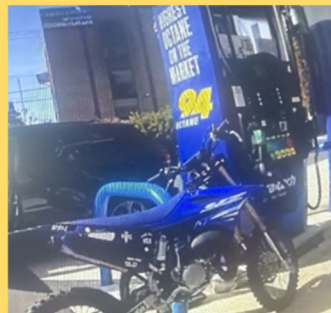
