

**AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION 20-427
WITH JACOBS ENGINEERING GROUP, INC.
RFP2020-28**

THE AMENDED AGREEMENT made this **29TH** day of **OCTOBER 2020**, by and between the **CITY OF TRENTON**, a Municipal Corporation, of the State of New Jersey, with principal offices located at 319 East State Street, Trenton, New Jersey 08608 (hereinafter the "City") and **JACOBS ENGINEERING GROUP, INC., 299 MADISON AVENUE, P.O. BOX 1936, MORRISTOWN, NEW JERSEY 07962-1936** (hereinafter "Professional Services").

WHEREAS, Resolution 20-427 was adopted and awarded on August 6, 2020, through a fair and open process in accordance per N.J.S.A. 19:44 A-204 Et. Seq to Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc., 299 Madison Avenue, P.O. Box 1936, Morristown, New Jersey 07962-1936 for Super Pulsator Washdown System Design and Bid Services for a period of one (1) year from August 7, 2020 to August 6, 2021 in an amount not to exceed \$79,000.00; and

WHEREAS, upon testing, it was determined via flow test that the pressure of the current power washing system is 60-70 psi which will be insufficient for the new system, as it requires a spray nozzle pressure of 80-90 psi; and

WHEREAS, Contract Amendment No. 1 to bring the total price of the contract from \$79,000.00 to \$97,750.00 that will cover the design and specifications of a booster pump that will increase the water pressure to 80-91 psi, as well as the expertise of an electrical engineer to properly design the electrical supply, instrumentation, and controls of the booster pump, and this additional work will all be included in the bid package produced by Jacobs Engineering Group; and

NOW THEREFORE, the parties mutually agree as follows:

1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an amended contract with Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc., 299 Madison Avenue, P.O. Box 1936, Morristown, New Jersey 07962-1936 for Super Pulsator Washdown System Design and Bid Services for the City of Trenton, Department of Water and Sewer, Trenton Water Works, Water Filtration Plant in an amount not to exceed \$18,750.00.
2. The amended contract shall remain in full force from August 7, 2020 to August 6, 2021 and shall not be extended without approval of the City Council of the City of Trenton.



WHEREAS, the City has a continuing need for Super Pulsator Washdown System Design and Bid Services for the Department of Water and Sewer, Trenton Water Works, Water Filtration Plant; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 20-427 was adopted and awarded on August 6, 2020, through a fair and open process in accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:44 A-20.4 et seq. to Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc., 299 Madison Avenue, P.O. Box 1936, Morristown, New Jersey 07962 to provide Super Pulsator Washdown System Design and Bid Services for a period of one (1) year in an amount not to exceed \$79,000; and


NOW, THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Trenton, as follows:
