# GENERAL OVERVIEW

---

The 2021 Annual Plan implements the goals and objectives of the Five-Year Consolidated Plan 2020-2024.

Focuses on funding from the CPD formula block grant programs: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program, and Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) Program.

The **Annual Action Plan** provides a concise summary of the actions, activities, and the specific federal and non-federal resources that will be used each year to address the priority needs and specific goals identified by the Consolidated Plan.

- Senior Center Operations \$ 172,000
- CEASE – Homeless Center \$ 75,000
- Job Training \$ 50,000
- Youth Education and Recreation \$ 250,000

# HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP

Housing Programs – provide safe and decent housing for low- and moderate-income households.

- Administration: \$87,074.90
- Rental Housing: \$480,861.75
- CHDO Set-aside: \$133,612.35



# EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT

---

- Administration: \$ 18,500
- HMIS: \$ 15,000
- Shelter programs: \$ 110,000

(Homefront \$30,000, Rescue Mission \$30,000 and Anchor House \$50,000)

- Homeless Prevention \$ 108,942
