CHANGE ORDER #1 TO THE CONTRACT WITH ALLIED CONSTRUCTION GROUP FOR CORROSION CONTROL
TREATMENT SYSTEM-PHASE II
BID2020-25

THE AGREEMENT made this 10TH day of NOVEMBER 2021, by and between the **CITY OF TRENTON**, a municipal corporation, of the State of New Jersey, with principal offices located at **319 EAST STATE STREET, TRENTON, NEW JERSEY 08608** (hereinafter the "City") and **ALLIED CONSTRUCTION GROUP, INC., ("ALLIED") 499 WASHINGTON ROAD, PARLIN, NEW JERSEY 08859** (hereinafter "CONTRACTOR")

WHEREAS, Allied Construction Group, Inc. ("Allied"), 499 Washington Road, Parlin, New Jersey 08859 was awarded the contract for BID2020-25, Corrosion Control Treatment System-Phase II in the amount of \$693,360.00 (See Exhibit A, Resolution 20-291); and

WHEREAS, the original job specifications for BID2020-25 was to design and build a chemical injection vault for injection of zinc orthophosphate into a portion of TWW's water-distribution system in order to prevent lead from leaching into the distribution system; and

WHEREAS, after the vault had been designed, and construction was underway, it was discovered that the groundwater level was not as deep as originally anticipated; and

WHEREAS, a sump pump is needed to remove groundwater seepage into the vault, as any seepage would damage the chemical injection system; and

WHEREAS, this work will require a change order in the amount of \$27,593.00 for a revised contract price in the amount of \$720,953.00 which is far below the 20% threshold amount for total contract amendments, as set forth in N.J.S.A. 5:30-11.3 (a) 9; and


WHEREAS, the additional work to be performed includes drilling through the underground vault wall, providing electrical service, integrating the alarm with the current monitoring system; and installation of the sump pump; and

NOW THEREFORE, the parties mutually agree as follows:

1. The total amount of the change order #1 shall amend the contract be in an amount not to exceed \$27,593.00 and the total amount of the change order is less than 20% of the original contract will not alter the contract in such a manner as to nullify the effect of the competitive determination of lowest responsible bidder which was made at the time of the contract award; and
2. The Mayor is hereby to execute authorized change order #1 with Allied Construction Group ("Allied"), 499 Washington Road, Parlin, New Jersey 08859 for said purposes in the manner prescribed by law. The grand total with change order #1 in an amount not to exceed \$27,593.00 is \$720,953.00.



**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER NUMBER 1 TO THE
CONTRACT WITH ALLIED CONSTRUCTION GROUP FOR CORROSION
CONTROL TREATMENT SYSTEM -PHASE II, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO
EXCEED \$27,593, FOR A REVISED CONTRACT PRICE
OF \$720,953- BID 2020-25**

WHEREAS, Allied Construction Group ("Allied") was awarded the contract for BID 2020-25, Corrosion Control Treatment System - Phase II in the amount of \$693,360 (See Exhibit A, Resolution 20-291); and

WHEREAS, the original job specification for BID 2020-25 was to design and build a Chemical Injection Vault for injection of zinc orthophosphate into a portion of TWW's water-distribution system in order to prevent lead from leaching into the distribution system; and

WHEREAS, after the vault had been designed, and construction was underway, it was discovered that the groundwater level was not as deep as originally anticipated; and

WHEREAS, a sump pump is needed to remove groundwater seepage into the vault, as any seepage would damage the chemical injection system; and

WHEREAS, funds for the additional work have been certified to be available Fiscal Year 2022 in operating account number 2-05-55-5500-899; and
