EMERGENCY PAYMENT ON AN EMERGENCY BASIS FOR DEMOLITION SERVICES IN THE CITY OF TRENTON FOR A 2 1/2 STORY WOOD FRAME STRUCTURE DUE TO A FIRE OPEN ROOF AREAS AND WALLS AT THE REAR IN A COLLAPSED STATE, LOCATED AT 816-818 S. CLINTON AVENUE, TRENTON, NEW JERSEY
ISSUED TO CARROLL GROUP, INC.

THE AGREEMENT made this 22nd day of OCTOBER 2021, by and between the **CITY OF TRENTON**, a municipal corporation, of the State of New Jersey, with principal offices located at **319 EAST STATE STREET, TRENTON, NEW JERSEY 08608** (hereinafter the "City") and **CARROLL GROUP, INC., 4 YOUNGS ROAD, HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY 08619** (hereinafter "CONTRACTOR")

WHEREAS, a need existed for the emergency services of Carroll Group, Inc., 4 Youngs Road, Hamilton, New Jersey 08619 for Demolition Services in the City of Trenton for a 2 1/2 story wood frame structure due to a fire open roof areas and walls at the rear in a collapsed state, located at 816-818 S. Clinton Avenue, Trenton, New Jersey due to a dilapidated structure which created an imminent hazard to the surrounding environment; and

WHEREAS, these properties are privately-owned and after the required notice to the owners they failed to mitigate the hazard; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contract Law at N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 provides that "[a]ny contract may be negotiated or awarded... without public advertising for bids and bidding therefore, notwithstanding that the contract price will exceed the bid threshold, when an emergency affecting the public health, safety and welfare requires the immediate...performance of services", subject to the award being made pursuant to the manner set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, the official in charge Henry Guarneri, Building Subcode Official submitted the attached certification that an emergency existed, and that immediate services to remedy the emergency were required; and

NOW THEREFORE, the parties mutually agree as follows:

1. The amount of the agreement shall be in an amount not to exceed \$27,690.00 for the City of Trenton, Department of Housing and Economic Development.
2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an emergency payment in an amount not to exceed \$27,690.00 to Carroll Group, Inc., 4 Youngs Road, Hamilton, New Jersey 08619 for Demolition Services in the City of Trenton for a 2 1/2 story wood frame structure due to a fire open roof areas and walls at the rear in a collapsed state, located at 816-818 S. Clinton Avenue, Trenton, New Jersey due to a dilapidated structure which created an imminent hazard to the surrounding environment for the City of Trenton, Department of Housing and Economic Development for the said purposes in the manner prescribed by law.







**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PAYMENT FOR A CONTRACT WITH
CARROLL GROUP INC, AWARDED FOR DEMOLITION SERVICES IN
THE CITY OF TRENTON FOR A STRUCTURE REMOVAL OF A 2 ½
STORY WOOD FRAME STRUCTURE DUE TO FIRE OPEN ROOF
AREAS AND WALLS AT THE REAR IN A COLLAPSED STATE,
LOCATED 816-818 S. CLINTON AVENUE,
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$27,690.00**

WHEREAS, a need existed for the emergency demolition services of Carroll Group, Inc. at 816-818 S. Clinton Avenue due a dilapidated structure which created an imminent hazard to the surrounding environment; and

WHEREAS, the maximum amount for the contract is not to exceed \$27,690.00 and funds have been certified to be available in Capital Budget Year 2020, Account Number C-04-20-65-008D-001, and

WHEREAS, these properties are privately-owned and after the required notice to the owners they failed to mitigate the hazard; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law at N.J.S.A.40A:11-6 provides that “[a]ny contract may be negotiated or awarded...without public advertising for bids and bidding therefore, notwithstanding that the contract price will exceed the bid threshold, when an emergency affecting the public health, safety and welfare requires the immediate...performance of services,” subject to the award being made pursuant to the manner set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, the official in charge Henry Guarneri, Building Subcode Official, submitted the attached certification that an emergency existed, and that immediate services to remedy the emergency were required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Trenton, in the County of Mercer as follows:

1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a payment in an amount not to exceed \$27,690.00 to Carroll Group, Inc, 4 Youngs Road, Hamilton, NJ 08618 for emergency demolition services 816-818 S. Clinton Avenue in the City of Trenton.


