2022 MAYOR'S SUMMER BASKETBALL LEAGUE

RULES

1. **Rosters:** All players must be on the roster at the start of the League, additional players can be added in case of another player getting seriously injured. The League Director must be aware of the additional players to roster.
2. **Game Duration:** Pee Wee Games will consist of four (4) quarters (6minutes each). Elementary, Middle and High School games will consist of four (4) quarters (8minutes each). The clock will be running time except the last two (2) minutes of the 4th quarter. Clock stops only for time-outs, jump balls and technical fouls, delay of game.
3. **Over time:** Over time periods will run until the last for three (3) minutes each. The clock will run until the last minute of the overtime period.
4. **Time outs:** Each team will have three (3) time- outs per half and one twenty (20) second time-out in the event of over time play. Time- outs do not carry over.
5. **Disqualification:** Each player gets five (5) fouls.
6. **Shooting penalties:** Penalty shots will be taken on the tenth 10th foul of each quarter. (10 fouls 2 shots)
7. **Fighting:** Fighting of any sort will result in immediate removal from the court area (including the bench) for the remaining duration of the League. NO EXCEPTIONS!!
8. **Technical fouls:** Players or coaches charged with two (2) technical fouls will be disqualified for the remainder of the game. The player or coach must sit down on the bench the remainder of the game.
9. **Classic attire:** Each player will be required to wear the uniform top provided. No player will be allowed to play without it. Each player is being asked to wear black shorts. Scarves and doo- rags are not permitted.
10. **Game time:** Each team is asked to arrive at least 20 minutes prior to their scheduled game time. This will be stressed on the day that team jerseys are dispersed. Games will start on time no matter what!
11. **Player requirements:** Each player must complete the registration form to play in the 2022 Mayor's Spring & Summer Basketball League. All players must have a copy of their ID with the registration forms to play in each age division. This prevents any questions on the correct age of a player.
12. **Jewelry:** No jewelry can be worn during the League play (earrings, watches, rings, bracelets, chains, etc.) for the safety of each player.

13. *No profanity / Trash talk:* The League will not tolerate profanity or trash talk from no player, parent or coach at no time during the 2022 Mayor's Spring & Summer Basketball League play or activities. All players and coaches will be warned first then technical second and third removed from the game.
