presents the following Ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE CONFIDENTIAL POSITION OF CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGIST IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES' NEWLY ESTABLISHED MENTAL HEALTH AND WELLNESS PROGRAM IN THE DIRECTOR'S OFFICE; SETTING FORTH CERTAIN REGULATIONS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SAME.

WHEREAS, the City of Trenton, Department of Health and Human Services needs a Clinical Psychologist to provide and supervise a program of mental health and psychological services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Trenton, Department of Health and Human Services needs a Clinical Psychologist to participate in administrative decision making within the Mental Health and Wellness Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Trenton, Department of Health and Human Services needs a Clinical Psychologist to supervise and instruct staff in the application of crisis intervention techniques in seeking and providing treatment for residents whose behavior threatens their own lives or those of others; and

WHEREAS, the City of Trenton, Department of Health and Human Services needs a Clinical Psychologist to actively participate in meetings or staffing regarding the placement activities of residents who have been or are about to be admitted or released; and

ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City of Trenton, Department of Health and Human services need a Clinical Psychologist, in connection with community education, interprets the psychological and mental health programs with community agencies, state and federal government agencies, hospitals, and other institutions, and make presentations before Organization and groups interested in or concerned about the problems of mental health within the City of Trenton; and

WHEREAS, the City of Trenton, Department of Health and Human Services needs a Clinical Psychologist to assist in providing job related counseling to employees with the City of Trenton whose performance, relationships with staff members, clients/residents, or follow up procedures and policies need to be improved; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services has the ability and expertise to create a Mental Health and Wellness Program to address any mental health needs and trauma due to the Pandemic, gun violence, domestic violence, increase in morbidity and mortality rates within the community; and

WHEREAS, the confidential title of Clinical Psychologist is not currently in existence in any City of Trenton's salary ordinance; therefore

The City Council of the City of Trenton does ordain as follows:

1. That from and after the effective dates herein, the schedule below showing the salary range for Clinical Psychologist, be recognized as duly created and existing in the City of Trenton.

2. The salary range shall be effective only upon the availability of funds as appropriated in the budget or budgets, including the temporary budget, as adopted by the City Council of the City of Trenton.
3. Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
4. This Ordinance shall be effective after final passage and publication.
5. This Ordinance shall be codified within the City of Trenton Code.
