Effective April 1, 2023, City of Trenton will be changing our health insurance administrator. Your health benefits offerings will not change; we have simply replaced the NJ State Health Benefits Program (NJ SHBP) – our current administrator – with our new administrators in the following manner:

- Aetna - Medical coverage for Actives and U65 Retirees. Same plan offerings
- Aetna – Medical coverage for 65+ Retirees and Disabled Employees. One plan Medicare Advantage \$10 copay includes Prescription Rx coverage
- Broadreach Medical Resources (BMR) – Optum network Rx prescription coverage for Actives and U65 Retirees
- MetLife – *New Benefit*. Vision plan for Actives. City of Trenton providing Employee only coverage at 100%
- Norton Lifelock – *New Benefit*. City of Trenton providing Benefit Premier Employee only coverage at 100%

We value you and appreciate all the hard work you do and your service to the City. We reviewed several options, and we believe these changes will best support the City's long-term growth.
